Reading: Everyday Texts and Understanding

- Follow instructions and understand everyday texts
- Find key information in short texts
- Identify the main idea and key details
- Put information in the right order (sequencing)
- Make simple inferences (what is implied)
- Compare two texts in a simple way (what is the same/different)
- Understand purpose and viewpoint in a simple way

Writing: Clear, Useful Writing

- Write clear sentences for a purpose
- Use punctuation to make meaning clear
- Write simple paragraphs
- Write forms, emails, and short letters
- Describe and recount experiences
- Plan and organise ideas before writing
- Edit and improve writing (spelling, punctuation, clarity)

Speaking, Listening and Communicating (SLC): Confidence and Communication

- Take turns in discussions and ask questions
- Listen actively and respond appropriately
- Give opinions with reasons
- Agree and disagree politely
- Use problem-solving conversations (talking through an issue and next steps)
- Give a short presentation (around 1–2 minutes)

Exam Readiness (Built In)
